1. Invitation

The Invitation is attached to this General Information.

2. Dates and Schedule

The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the H&N Cup is attached to this General Information. The final update of the Schedule will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulation

The H&N Cup will be conducted according to the actual ISSF rules and regulations – detailed Information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org
ISSF Jurys (Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the BSSB to supervise the H&N Cup. Qualified range officers will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment control will be conducted according to ISSF rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to equipment control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to equipment control for inspection.

Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to equipment control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use.

Rifle athletes can have only one jacket and trousers used in this competition.

Rifle clothing post-competition stiffness testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be dis-



qualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete. The athlete can continue using this clothing in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO2 cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This can be checked by equipment control.

4. Participation

Individual Events

ISSF member federations can enter a maximum of four (4) athletes in individual events AR / AP men / women and a maximum of six (6) athletes in individual events AR / AP jm / jw. A maximum of four (4) athletes of one nation (the four top-ranked after qualification) may proceed to the Final.

Mixed Team Events

Mixed team events will be included in the competition schedule. These events are as follows: 10m Air Pistol Mixed Team, 10m Air Rifle Mixed Team. ISSF member federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman, open class (juniors and adults). After all final entry have been received, it is possible to register additional Mixed Teams per nation, but only 2 teams per nation will start in the qualification for the medal matches. All other teams RPO.

Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each H&N Cup event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges/firing points.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the final entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. The organizing committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated

5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and final entries for athletes and officials must be submitted to organisation committee. All other registration forms must be returned to the organizing committee (see also: "summary of deadlines")

Preliminary Entries

ISSF member federations entering the H&N Cup must submit the preliminary entries not later than **1 DEC 2026**.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All team leaders of ISSF member federation delegations must report to the OC entries official and confirm their final entries. The confirmation must be received by 6 p.m. the day before the first competition.

Entry Changes

Changes are possible after January 6th.

Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration and doping control.

Fee description:

€ 60 final entry fee per athlete / two single events

€ 60 final entry fee per Mixed Team

The "hotel – shooting range" and "shooting range – hotel" transfer service costs a one-time fee of **€ 25** per person for all days.

The "airport – hotel" and "hotel – airport" transfer service costs **€ 10 per person for one way**.
Payment has to be made at the organizing office.

Payment of Entry Fees

All payments must be made in cash in € (EUR) also by MASTER-and VISA cards. There will be no currency exchange at the Shooting Range.

All payments are made on the shooting range can be done between 20 JAN 2026 and 24 JAN 2026 (4 pm.), the treasury will be open from 9 am. to 4 pm.



6. Shooting Range

The H&N Cup will take place at the Munich 1972 Olympic Shooting Range – Garching

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range description:

10m hall 100 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG final hall 10 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG Limited unofficial training will be part of the schedule

IMPORTANT

The shooting range will NOT be open for training before **20 JAN 2026**.

7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

Entry Visa

The participating federations, which require entry visa into GERMANY, are kindly requested to obtain it before departure from their country. Contact German Embassy or Consulate in their respective countries, or where required in case of countries having no diplomatic relations with Germany.

The Bavarian Shooting Sport Confederation has no influence on the embassy and can provide the invitation regarding the H&N Cup only!

Gun License

All participating federations must not declare all air rifles or air pistols with a "F" in a pentagon and ammunitions for AR / AP brought to Germany.

All AR of SP have to be declared to the airline by IATA rules.

Custom Clearance – Arrival

All delegations are requested to arrange the MUC Airport (Munich – Franz-Josef-Strauss International Airport) for arrival and departure. Main international airlines can reach MUC Airport directly.

If there is any delegation or athlete who choose a flight that the first stop in Germany will be at another Airport (for example FRA, Frankfurt Rhein Main Airport), the custom process will be not automatic and can take much more time than in MUC.

At the airport, arriving athletes are asked to use the red exit and declare their AR or AP at customs. You should carry the invitation for the competition with you. A special form from the German weapons authority is not necessary.

9. Travel and Transportation

Travel – Arrival

All arrival and departure must be from MUC International Airport – Franz-Josef Strauss, Munich. The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the airport to the shooting range to leave the guns and then to the official hotels. Transportation back to the airport will be provided as well.

The “airport – hotel” and “hotel – airport transfer” service costs € 10 per person for one way. Payment is to be made at the organizing office.

The official transportation begins:

19 JAN 2026 (at 08:00 AM) and ends on 26 JAN 2026 (at 8:00 PM).

If travel information is provided to the organizing committee, a representative will be at the MUC Airport to welcome the delegations.

Delegations that arrive before the official arrival day or leave after the Official Departure Day must make their own arrangements.

If requested in advance, but not later than **17 JAN 2026**, the OC will arrange airport pick-up service. Airport pick up – transportation to the official hotels (and back for departure)

The MUC airport is located 26 km from the Olympic Shooting Range Munich. The Olympic Shooting Range is located 5 km from the official hotels.

Upon arrival all delegations must take the transportation to the shooting range, leave the guns and go to the official hotels.

If you need transportation to the airport for your arrival and/or departure, please ask Mrs. Petra Horneber, email: petra.horneber@bssb.bayern and let her know your arrival or departure time and flight number.

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

Local transportation will be provided between the shooting range and the official hotels only.

A schedule will be published in each hotel lobby with exact times of departure to the range and back.

Please check the designated area in the lobby daily for this information.

On days with a lot of traffic it will take 30 minutes from the hotels to the shooting range. On days with moderate traffic it will take 20 minutes.



10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The technical meeting for will take place on **20 JAN 2026, 6:30 PM**, at the final hall.

Each participating ISSF member federation should have at least one representative present at the technical meeting to receive updated information regarding final competition schedule (including training schedule), draw procedures and other important issues related to the H&N Cup.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

Gun storage will be provided conveniently at the shooting range basement of the airgun hall. Firearms and ammunition will not be transported to and from the hotels, except on departure. A storage space will be provided for equipment bags and ammunition at the shooting range on the left side of the final hall.

11. Ceremonies

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the Rifle/Pistol Final Hall immediately after the end of each Finals (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the Ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).
